- Parents are expected to insure any device brought to school.
- All reasonable efforts will be taken to retrieve lost devices and normal school behaviour management policy and procedures will apply.
- Repairs, maintenance, updates etc are the responsibility of parents.
- Up to date security software must be installed.
- The school will require any BYOD device to have a small piece of software installed, to assist with monitoring of internet use. This will only operate while the device is connected to the school network. At these times, teachers will have the ability to monitor or block any internet (or other) activity that they deem to be inappropriate. If this software is removed, the student account will be suspended for 2 weeks or as decided by the staff involved. This will mean that the student will be unable to access the school network during this time.

n the event that inappropriate or unacceptable content is found then normal school behavious management procedures will apply and the provisions of the Computer and ICT Acceptables Agreement enacted.
