# Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Well you all made it! The last week of the school year! Thanks to everyone in our wider school community for an awesome year with lots of incredible learning here at Cornerstone Christian School. We pray that all our students have a safe and restful summer break and return to us safely on the first day of term next year – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> of February 2020.

You know, I love this time of year – the excitement of Christmas; decorating the Christmas tree and the anticipation of family visitors, a shared meal together, and of course presents on Christmas day. Being a Christian, adds another layer on top of these important Christmas rituals and traditions; it's the day where we celebrate the crazy idea that the same mighty God who breathed the stars into existence (Psalm 33:6) made Himself become utterly small – a tiny foetus in fact, just so that He could be one of us – Emmanuel, allowing mankind to see what He was really like. I love how Phillip Yancey puts it in his book 'The Jesus I never knew':

Before Jesus, almost no pagan author had used "humble" as a compliment. Yet the events of Christmas point inescapably to what seems like an oxymoron: a 'humble God'. The God who came to earth came not in a raging whirlwind nor in a devouring fire. Unimaginably, the Maker of all things shrank down, down, so small as to become an ovum, a single fertilized egg barely visible to the naked eye, an egg that would divide and re-divide until a foetus took shape, enlarging cell by cell inside a nervous teenager. "Immensity cloistered in thy dear womb," marvelled the poet John Donne. He "made himself nothing ... he humbled himself," said the apostle Paul more prosaically.

The Messiah who showed up as the baby Jesus, wore a different kind of God-glory, the glory of humility. 'God is great,' is the cry of the Moslems - a truth which is self-evident through the glory of creation. The God who roared, who appeared to order armies and empires about like pawns on a chessboard, this God emerged in Palestine as a baby who could not speak or eat solid food or control his bladder, who depended on a teenage girl for shelter, food, and love. God's visit to earth took place in an animal shelter with no attendants present and nowhere to lay the new-born king but a feed trough. Indeed, the event that divided history, and even our calendars, into two parts may have had more animal than human witnesses. "How silently, how silently, the wondrous gift is given."

We are still in the process of confirming our new sports uniform design. We will notify you via the school newsletter once this is available to purchase.


