Cornerstone Fundraising Group – All Weather Artificial Turf

It is 8-10 years ago that a group of parents (including myself) set out with a vision to have an artificial all-weather turf here at Cornerstone.

With muddy sports fields and a growing passion for hockey, the CFG at the time started the fundraising goal of raising funds towards an all-weather turf. Over many galas and other initiatives, you, our community and supporters, have managed to raise approximately \$100,000.

Working with the Proprietors and the Cornerstone Christian Education Trust, the Cornerstone Fundraising Group at the time realised that this was great seed money toward the project, but well short of something that we could be proud of, and something that would not outgrow our fast growing school. The CFG gifted that money to CCET to be held in trust as we realised it would be closer to \$700,000 to \$1.3 million dollars to build something fantastic.

It is timely to share our continued commitment to this project and tell you that by no means has this project been shelved or stopped. Far from it!

As a Trust, we have had many major ongoing projects over the last 4-5 years, with the following being of high priority: our fantastic school gym, a special-needs unit (Waiata), a new secondary block (L block) and a few smaller projects. I want to assure you that the funds our community raised are in the bank and that the turf project is still something we discuss at most Trust meetings, and I will continue to champion this.

We are unable to give an exact time that the project will be delivered to the school, as the demand for learning spaces is always our first priority, but we will continue to work with School Management on this project and as soon as we can, we will deliver (like all our other awesome facilities), something that will be future-proof and of an excellent standard.

We hope this helps you to understand that the project is still alive and well, and that CCET are committed to seeing it to its fruition.
