## **CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS**

# SOME HELPFUL INFORMATION

- Homework is set each week. Children are expected to read each night as well as to learn their memory verse and spelling words from Monday to Thursday. These words will be tested on Friday. There will be other tasks that teachers will set every week. We encourage children to go to the library as most children will not bring reading books home.
- We welcome parents to attend Tumanako Team assemblies, which occur on Fridays at 2:20pm, in the Library.
- Please notify the school office of all absences. They oversee this process and follow up on any students who are marked as not present by the teacher on the school roll. Feel free to let the classroom teacher know, but in the first instance contact the office.
- Payments These are the payment options to make it easier for parents to pay small amounts. The two options are:
  - 1. Online This is the preferred payment option. The Cornerstone bank account number is: 02-0727-0154852-00. Student name and event will need to be included.
  - 2. Cash Box The correct money must be in a sealed envelope with student name, class and event written on it.
- Waste Minimization Strategy We want to continue to encourage students to be responsible for their own rubbish, recycling and composting. Part of this will include students taking home their own lunch rubbish. There will be bins for messy foods like yoghurt containers. Fruit and vegetable scraps can be composted.
- This year we will be doing our traditional portfolios in a digital form using Class Dojo. In order to receive the Portfolio learning, you will need to have signed up to Class Dojo. Your child's teacher will provide sign up details if you are not already connected.
- Following the community BBQ on the 14<sup>th</sup> of February, the Tumanako Team teachers will pop over to their classes for around 30 minutes for a chat with anyone who wanted to meet us and ask any questions or have a look in class. The BBQ starts at 5:00 and the classrooms will be attended around 6:00.
- We have several children in our team and the wider school community with <u>severe</u> allergies to peanuts. Please avoid sending any nuts, peanuts or peanut butter to school in the children's lunches.
