Click "Start" (View the Requirements List). From here you can select your child's class/year and/or subjects and follow the instructions. If you prefer, you can phone the OfficeMax/MySchool team on 0800 724 440 Monday to Friday, 8.30am - 5pm.

This year OfficeMax have introduced Laybuy, so you can pay in 6 weekly, interest-free instalments, and still get your order right away. If you order in December, you'll be able to choose to receive your order straight away or after you get home from holiday in January.

In addition, all orders placed online in December will receive a FREE A4 Magnetic Family Organiser - ideal for keeping activities and events on track throughout the year.

Please do not leave ordering your child/s stationery to the last minute. Just before school starts, OfficeMax and the courier are really busy, so there may be a delay of up to 4 working days. We would suggest ordering no later than 2 weeks before school starts.

Please note, the 2021 Secondary School timetable will not be available until mid-January when it will be able to be accessed via the KAMAR portal or app (same login details for both).

Students won't know what their confirmed option subjects are until then or at the Year 11-13 course confirmation afternoon on 28th January.

Because of this, we understand that subject-specific stationery will not be able to be ordered until courses are confirmed. However, starting the year with paper and a pen as well as the student's BYOD laptop will be sufficient until courses are confirmed and stationery can be ordered.

Stationery Lists

Stationery Lists will be put up on our school website in early January for those that don't require a full class stationery pack and/or those that want to purchase elsewhere. We would like to encourage families to use OfficeMax for their stationery requirements where possible. Their prices are very competitive.

Most Primary class lists have mostly exercise books in the stationery pack and then Buy Now or Bring from home eg rulers, rubbers, pens, pencils, etc. Teachers have spent a lot of time preparing specific stationery for each subject/class.

Please be mindful of the following when purchasing from other suppliers: In previous years, parents have purchased the wrong exercise books when purchasing from other suppliers. Please try and buy the equivalent. We have also noted that equivalent items from other suppliers, eg exercise books are often of poorer quality. We have confidence that items purchased from OfficeMax are fit for purpose.
