Finally, some clarification for those who have asked. We do not have 'detentions' in the primary school. If there is an ongoing <u>behaviour</u> problem, the child would also sit with the 'lunch work' teacher and write on a 'Thinking Time' page so that they can reflect on their choices. You would receive a copy of this page too. Our desire is not to just punish children for their actions but rather to teach them a better way to manage things next time.
