Board of Trustees (BOT)

We recently had our Board of Trustees elections and so now have the outstanding group of people below as our governing body. The first order of business for a new board is to elect their chair and deputy chair. We had our first board meeting at the end of last term and it is my pleasure to announce that **Jo Auer** was elected as our new Chairperson and **Braden Simpson** was elected as the Deputy Chair – my congratulations to both.

By law, the makeup of a BOT of a state-integrated school (which we are) must have one more parent trustee than proprietor trustee, as even though the proprietors own the land and the buildings (and hence why parents pay attendance dues – which effectively pays the proprietor mortgage on these), state integrated schools are still effectively state schools, and are state funded. As a result, the "balance of power" on a Board must reside with the number of parent trustees, so we are still effectively a community school (as prescribed in the Education Act).
