Open days, enrolments, waiting lists, roll caps and new teachers

Our school has been blessed with significant roll growth over the last few years and this has impacted on many aspects of school life. Looking at the school staff photos over the past few years I counted: In 1996 there were 6 staff, in 2013 there were 25 staff, in 2018 there were 60 staff and in 2019 70 staff. This has had significant impact, but we are only allowed to grow so much under our Ministry of Education imposed roll cap. Some of the ways the demand has impacted have included:

- The school is usually at its full roll cap and so we have waiting lists at most year levels (currently well over 100 on the waiting list). People do leave for other places, so students on the waiting list do get into the school, but, generally not when they originally tried to enrol. It is really tough putting keen families on the waiting list when they are wanting Christian Education for their child (which is what we are here for).
- We have a roll cap of 580 for next year and we are currently asking the Ministry of Education to increase this to 730 to allow us to have 2 classes flowing right through the school (currently we have 2 classes up to Year 9).
- Our new entrant classes are full for the next two years, and we are half full for 2022, so have been advising parents for some time to get the enrolment for their child into the office when they turn two to ensure there is a place for them when they start school.
- We are currently advertising for 3 new teachers in the Y7-9 area to account for some of the growth coming through.
- We had an open day on Wednesday, but, we actually ran it for information for our Year 6's and Year 8's as opposed to advertising for new enrolments since there is limited space in each year level.

School Photos

2. <u>Ordering Online</u>: (If paying online <u>DO NOT</u> return envelope). Go to <u>www.lcscott.co.nz</u>, select order online, follow the order instructions and pay using internet banking (POLi) or credit/debit card <u>BEFORE</u> Photo Day.

All students present will be included in class photographs and also photographed individually regardless of whether they have returned payment envelopes or not.

On photo day, students will be issued with an internet access key to enable all parents' access to online viewing of the photographs and to allow online ordering after photo day for those that have not pre-ordered.

School Photos/Sibling Photographs

There are sibling photo envelopes available at reception if you would like your children to have a sibling photograph together. Family photos must be ordered **<u>BEFORE</u>** photo day to ensure a photo is taken. These will need to be returned to the school office **<u>BEFORE</u>** photo day.

New Entrant Enrolments

We are experiencing significant pressure on our roll and have waiting lists at most year levels. Enrolling your pre-schooler <u>before they turn 2</u> will help to ensure there is a space for them when they are ready to start school, and will avoid the sad situation some parents have experienced whereby their child is not able to be enrolled due to the year level being full.
