A New Venture for Providing Cheap Laptops for Parents

At this week's Board meeting, we considered a new venture to assist our community and I would like to announce it today.

Mr Paul Jorgensen is our IT Manager and he is very thorough with his organisation of our network. As a side line, Paul has become very proficient at obtaining high quality second-hand laptops for our school at a fraction of their original cost. These machines are now throughout the school and tend to have a lifetime of about 4-5 years (at which time laptops are out of date and need replacing anyway).

There are a plethora of low cost new laptops available from suppliers these days, however, they are not of the "Enterprise" quality to make them useful as student machines. I visited another Christian school the other week and found they were asking their parents to spend \$1600-2600 for their compulsory laptops.

We can do this much cheaper and hence we came up with a cunning idea.

We regularly source these laptops for our students as and when they come up (on Trade Me) – Paul has systems set up to purchase them when they become available if they are of the right type.

We would like to offer these to parents for \$400. This is an incredibly low cost solution for parents. We will make somewhere around \$100/unit profit at this price and we would like to put this income to our hardship budget so that we can continue to bless families who find it difficult to pay for school related costs eg laptops, uniform etc (we are not able to make contributions to proprietor attendance dues).

So this initiative will achieve two things:

- 1. Provide low cost laptops to parents (we will be able to attach them to our network etc and will be responsible to ensure they work properly).
- 2. Provide funds for those in our community who are in financial hardship.
