

Teacher Job Description

Qualifications

The teacher must have a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

The teacher shall relate to, and must consistently attend, a local Christian church.

The teacher shall accept and recognise a responsibility to maintain and uphold the Special Character of the School.

The teacher will be an example of Christian living and daily demonstrate a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ by the way they relate to children, parents, staff and school administrators.

The teacher will understand and abide by the Code of Conduct

Teaching Responsibilities

The teacher will use the Bible as the basis for exploring God's world and as a standard against which to compare and interpret all curriculum material.

The teacher will adequately plan units and daily lessons based on children's needs in accordance with the Special Character and the Christian curriculum of the school and the National Curriculum documents.

The teacher will monitor and maintain assessment of children's learning in all areas.

The teacher will use a variety of teaching techniques to meet the learning needs of the children.

The teacher will maintain class routines and a working atmosphere and environment that provides opportunity for effective learning.

The teacher will establish effective relationships with children and encourage and praise students to develop a positive and safe learning environment.

The teacher will set clear standards of acceptable behaviour and consistently and fairly apply these within the philosophy, policy and procedures of the school.

The teacher will provide an interesting and stimulating classroom programme.

The teacher will maintain all administrative functions as required by the Principal, and school policies and procedures.

School Wide Responsibilities

The teacher will work for the overall good of the school with an aim to provide an environment where children will develop a closer relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

The teacher will teach according to the Christian character of the school, take part in the school's curriculum development programme and will upskill teaching knowledge on an on-going basis.

The teacher will take part in the Performance Appraisal process within the school.

The teacher will take responsibility for the development of curriculum areas as negotiated.

The teacher will co-operate with other staff members and support one another through encouragement and prayer.

The teacher will maintain open and honest communication with parents in regard to their child's progress.

The teacher will regularly report to parents in line with the procedures of the school.

The teacher will maintain confidentiality in regards to other children, parents and staff when communicating with others.

The teacher will fully meet professional standards in accordance with the practising teacher criteria.
