School Costs and Camps 2020

There has been a bit of discussion in the media recently about the new voluntary donations scheme, and the Ministry of Education have been sending out all sorts of directions to every school in the country around this.

We have decided to adopt this scheme for 2020. Basically, it gives the school an extra \$150 per student if schools don't charge school fees (N.B. proprietor attendance dues are not school fees).

The Ministry of Education has recently published new guidelines, further reducing what schools can charge for, which reflects the Labour party's pre-election promise to make the cost of education free.

A direct result of this is that we will not be charging parents for trips or camps, while part of this scheme, such as to the recycling centre or Te Manawa or the University. Full curriculum trips such as the Year 12 Biology trip, will now be paid for by the school.

Sports events and teams are outside the curriculum and will still be charged for.

Camps are a grey area. Camps are expensive and are not really part of the curriculum, although you could argue they are part of a good education. Schools cannot really afford to fund the costs of camps and have never had to in the past, therefore some schools are considering not offering them anymore. Going forward, we have decided to continue, at the present time, with our camps at the end of primary and end of secondary. We will ask parents for a voluntary donation towards these camps, but students will be able to attend them regardless. If we find that not enough voluntary donations are paid (ie to cover the cost of the camp per student) and therefore the cost to the school is too significant, we may reconsider running these camps in the future. We will be continuing with the already planned camps next year.

Regarding camps in 2020: If you can't afford to pay for your child to attend camp, the school is happy to pay for this. If you can afford to pay for your child to attend camp, please pay the voluntary donation so that we can continue to run them in the future.

For camps coming up:

2019 - Year 10 Camp (December): Does not apply. Parents will need to pay this cost if their child is to attend. (We are not expecting to run this camp in 2020).

2020 Year 7-8 MiCamp (March): We ask for a voluntary donation, but the camp will go ahead regardless. (If we do not receive enough donations, this camp may be reconsidered in the future).

2020 Year 6 Camp to Rangi Woods (March): We ask for a voluntary donation, but the camp will go ahead regardless.

2020 Year 13 Camp (February): We ask for a voluntary donation, but the camp will go ahead regardless.

If you have already paid for one of these camps above, you are entitled to have this money refunded. If you would like to have this money refunded, please contact the school office.

So, although this does throw up a few curly questions, basically it will reduce the overall costs to parents and particularly those who struggle to make ends meet, which is a good thing.




