# **Acting Principal's Message**

Thanks for the great parent turnout last Friday at the Year 7 to 13 Swimming Sports at the Makino Pool in Feilding. This is one of the things I love the most about Cornerstone Christian School the close connection that we have between School and Home. It was great to see so many Mums and Dads taking time out to encourage their child/ren (and others) in their events in the pool. We had a fantastic fun-filled day, full of friendly swimming competition and a few water-related tribe crazy dreamed up by Mr Craig McDonald - the organiser extraordinaire!

The Ministry of Health School Based Immunisation Programmes will again be offered by Public Health in 2020. Parent consent forms have gone home to Year 7 and 8 students for the below immunisation/vaccine. Please return consent forms before Friday 28th February. Even if you do not want your child to have the Immunisation/Vaccination, please fill out the DO NOT CONSENT part of the form.

<u>Year 7 Immunisation</u>: Boostrix – a booster to help protect against infection from tetanus, diphtheria and whooping cough (pertussis). To be given on 8th May 2020.

Year 8 HPV Vaccination: Human Papillomavirus Vaccine - Dose 1: 8th May 2020, Dose 2: 5<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

#### **New PE Uniform**

From Term 2 (Tuesday 28 April) we will be introducing our new PE/sports uniform for Year 7-10. This uniform will be used for Physical Education lessons and will also be used as the uniform for those playing in junior school sports teams. To enable this, each shirt will have a unique number that stays with the student for the duration of the time they are at school. If parents wish to pass their child's PE uniform onto other siblings, they can do so, but they will need to inform the school so that we can update the sports uniform register. There is a boys' cut (pictured right) and a girls' cut (pictured below). The shorts come in two designs, unisex or girls. Girls have the choice of wearing the unisex option or the girl's shorts.





Students that have an existing school PE uniform, will not have to purchase a new one, unless they are playing in a junior (Year 7 – 10) school sports team, as uniforms for these teams will no longer be issued. In this instance, they will need to purchase a new top to wear as their uniform for their sports team, although they may continue to wear the existing blue shorts if they have them. The sizing charts will be emailed with this newsletter and will also be sent via the school app. There will also be paper copies available from the school reception.

Can you please measure your child and choose the shirt and shorts as per the sizing chart. If you are unsure, there will be sample sizes available to try on at the uniform shop (student reception). The cost of the shirt will be \$40 and the shorts are \$40. Orders need to be placed by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March (Week 6) by emailing ilona@cornerstone.ac.nz or by delivering your child's size chart to Ilona Shewell in the school office with your child's name, classroom and size on it. Payment needs to be made at the time of ordering please. As these shirts are being manufactured specifically for us, there will be a wait time of approximately 6-8 weeks before they will be available to collect.

# **Swimming Sports**




