Principal's Message

Dear Parents/Kia ora te whanau/Malo e lelei/Talofa lava/Bula Vinaka/Konnichi wa/Kia orana/ Namaste/Welkom/Ni hao,

On the whiteboard in the staffroom there is a whakatauki or Maori proverb written on the weekly planner. It reads:

'He Tumanako! E hoa ma, ina te ora o te tangata' or in English: 'Hope! My friends, this is the essence of life!'

In the strange and slightly surreal season we find ourselves in, where all the world seems in disarray over COVID, more than ever we need Hope – Hope that things will get better. Hope that God has got this; Hope that has a name - Jesus, who according to scripture is the one who anchors our soul (Hebrews 6:19).

I have Hope or perhaps I should say 'many hopes' for our school. The other staff member leaving us is the lovely Mrs Francelle Aiken, who will retire from Cornerstone Christian School at the end of term 4. When I think back on Francelle's long teaching career and the sheer number of students she has taught and positively impacted for Christ, I

am humbled. The teaching profession and Cornerstone in particular will lose an incredibly experienced practitioner when you hang up your whiteboard markers at the end of the year Francelle!

We have advertised these two positions in the Education Gazette and will look to appoint new teachers to both of these positions later in the term.

We are also looking to restructure our leadership team within the school to ensure that we are positioned as best we possibly can for future growth. With Mr James Rose now as the sole Deputy Principal in school, we are currently looking internally to appoint two Assistant Principals (AP's). One AP will be the new head of Primary and the other AP will be the new head of Secondary. Please stand with us in prayer as we seek to make these two important appointments mid to late term 3.

Other Important Information

I am looking forward to catching up with many parents and whanau next Tuesday and Wednesday when we hold Parent Teacher Interviews/Learning Conferences across the school. If you haven't booked in for these already, please remember to do so (see notice later in this newsletter). We'd love to see you!

Just a reminder to all parents that the earliest drop off time for your children at school is 8.30am. We have been having a number of children turn up at school at 8.00am or earlier. Please be aware that often teachers are in meetings at this time or doing their own classroom preparation and therefore children arriving at school prior to 8.30am are unsupervised.

Can I please also remind parents of a few school uniform requirements that I would like to tighten up on:

- 1. All children are required to enter and leave the school gate in the correct school uniform. This includes shoes on feet.
- 2. Please remember that there is a requirement for all shoes worn at Cornerstone to be the same or very similar to the list of appropriate Cornerstone shoes shown on the right. <u>Coloured shoes or sport shoes with coloured</u> <u>soles are not appropriate.</u>



3. Students may wear a black raincoat or jacket to school; however, these are NOT to be worn

in place of the regulation red school cardigan or jersey and must be removed when inside the classroom.

4. We would like all students in year 7 to 10 to adopt the new sports and PE uniform that was released earlier this year. This is to be worn for all PE sessions, rather than the standard school uniform. Please see Ilona in the school student office to order this.

Please note that if you are experiencing financial hardship at present due to COVID or other circumstances, and are unable to afford the correct school uniform, please drop me an email as we do have available a small fund to assist school families with uniform purchases.

Term 3, Year 1-13 Learning Conferences

Term Three Learning Conferences will be held on *Tuesday the 4th of August and Wednesday the 5th of August.*

- On Tuesday 4th August, school will finish at the earlier time of 1pm for all students. <u>Please</u> <u>make arrangements to collect your children at this earlier time</u>. (The Feilding and Ashhurst buses will be at Cornerstone at the earlier time of 1pm).
- On Wednesday 5th August, Y1-6 students will finish school at 3pm as normal, **Y7-13 will** finish again at 1pm. <u>Please make arrangements to collect your children at this earlier time</u>. (The Feilding and Ashhurst buses will be leaving Cornerstone at the usual times today).

The booking system is now open for parents to book a Learning Conference with their child's teacher.

- For Y1-6, this will be with their classroom teacher. (This is a Parent/Teacher ONLY conference).
- For Y7-13, this will be with their Life Lab Teacher. (Parent/Student & Teacher conference)

Learning Conferences run for:

- 10 minutes in Year 1-6
- 20 minutes in Year 7-8
- 40 minutes in Year 9-13

To do this, please follow the instructions below.

How to Book a Learning Conference:

- a. Go to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz
- b. Click "Make a Booking"
- c. Enter the event code: xqrk5
- d. Follow the onscreen instructions to book a Learning Conference
 - i. Repeat for each child you have in Year 1-13
 - ii. One conference per child

All bookings need to be made before 5pm Monday 3rd of August. After this time, the School Interviews booking system will be closed to further bookings.

If you need any assistance with booking, please contact Mrs Wilkins in the school office. COVID-19 Awareness: If you or your child is unwell on the day, please stay home. Email the teacher directly if you need to cancel a booking.

Parents of students who normally catch a bus after school: For days where there is an early finish, please email <u>jean@cornerstone.ac.nz</u> before 3.30pm of the day before to register your child for school supervision through to the bus departure time.

Parents of students who can't be collected until the normal school finish time: For days where there is an early finish, please email <u>jean@cornerstone.ac.nz</u> before 3.30pm of the day before to register your child for school supervision through to the normal school finish time.

2. <u>Ordering Online</u>: (If paying online <u>DO NOT</u> return the envelope). Go to <u>www.lcscott.co.nz</u>, select order online, follow the order instructions and pay using internet banking (POLi) or credit/debit card <u>BEFORE</u> Photo Day.

All students present will be included in class photographs and also photographed individually regardless of whether they have returned payment envelopes or not. Students will be issued with an internet access key on photo day, to enable all parents' access to online viewing of the photographs and to allow online ordering after photo day for those that have not pre-ordered.
