Principal's Message

We have had an excellent start to the term so far. Yes, there have been a few little glitches to work out, but there is an awesome sense around school of things humming along and of God's peace resting on us as a school.

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While this Ministry top-up does not realistically meet the full cost of Outdoor Education at Cornerstone, we have decided to commit long-term to providing a Year 6, Year 8, Year 9 Activity Week and Year 10 and Year 13 camp for Cornerstone Christian School students.

School Based Immunisation Programme - Year 7 & 8

The Ministry of Health School Based Immunisation Programmes are being offered to our Year 7 and 8 students by Public Health. Consent forms have been given to all of our Year 7 and 8 students and *need to be returned to their Life Lab Teacher on MONDAY 15th February.* On Monday 15th March, Year 7's with consent will be given the dTap Vaccination and the Year 8's with consent will be given Dose 1 of the HPV Vaccination. On 20th of September the Year 8's with consent will be given Dose 2 of the HPV Vaccination.

Vision & Hearing Screening - New Entrants/Year 7's

The Vision and Hearing Technician will be visiting the school on Wednesday 17th February at 11.30am to do routine hearing and vision screening of our New Entrant and Year 7 students. Cornerstone Christian School App


The School App allows parents to have instant access to important school information like the school calendar, student absences, sports information, school newsletter and so on.

At the start of 2021, can we please remind parents that it is important that they ensure they have phone notifications for the School App turned on and that they are subscribed to the correct Alert Groups.

To set up the correct Alerts, please click on the symbol at the top left of the phone screen and then click Alert Subscriptions (see right).





You can then subscribe to Alert Groups like your child's 2021 classroom or team, your child's sports teams and so on.

Choosing specific alert groups will ensure that you only receive alerts that are important to you and your family.

If you haven't done so already, to get the Cornerstone School App on your phone, search 'School Apps NZ' on your phone's App store (both Apple App Store and Android's Google Play Store) and download the App to your device. Once downloaded, search for Cornerstone Christian School and follow the setup instructions on your phone's screen.


