#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents /Kia ora te whanau/Malo e lelei/Talofa lava/Bula Vinaka/Konnichi wa/Kia orana/ Namaste/Welkom/Ni hao,

As indicated in last week's newsletter, the Board of Trustees have created a school survey for all parents and caregivers to invite feedback on how our school should implement the health curriculum here at Cornerstone Christian School. Current education legislation require boards of trustees, at least once every two years to:



- Inform the school community about the content of the health education components of the curriculum;
- Consult with members of the school community regarding the way in which the school should implement health education;
- Describe, in broad terms, the health education needs of the school's students.

It is super important that we hear parent voice around the 'how', 'when' and 'what' of what should be taught to our students in these key areas of the health curriculum: Mental health, Sexuality education, Food and nutrition, Body care and physical safety, Physical activity, Sport studies and Outdoor education.

It goes without saying that some of these topics can be contentious and involve moral and ethical decisions that must be navigated through the framework of Christ's love. Ultimately, what the Bible states has to be what determines our moral compass – our foundation of truth.

Matthew 5:13-14: "You are the salt of the earth: but if the salt has become tasteless how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden, nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lamp stand, it gives light to all who are in the house ..."

The moral foundation the Bible presents on issues like sexuality or sex outside of marriage, is often considered to be outdated and intolerant in today's culture, yet we must hold onto the Biblical Truths of Jesus Christ with unwavering conviction, while still ensuring that we still hold the first Biblical

commandment dear – to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength and love your neighbor as yourself. This is the careful balance of truth and grace that our school must navigate.


