Today as I walked around Cornerstone Christian School, I was struck afresh by all of the fantastic students, teachers, office staff, caretakers and parents we have. I love working here and being a part of something that is greater than myself – a place where people try on a daily basis to do the best that they possibly can for God. We don't get it 100% perfect, but I do see people trying their best to live out the scripture in Colossians chapter 3, verse 23 that says:

I would like to draw attention to a group of parents doing an awesome mahi (work) on behalf of our school – the Cornerstone Fundraising Group or CFG as they are more commonly known. approached the CFG with a funding proposal for a new flash digital desk. The CFG considered the boys' proposal and felt this was a worthwhile project to fund.

Similarly the CFG donates money to a large number of sports events and trips through funds raised from various projects.

This year we made the decision not to run a Gala event in March, but rather, put on one school community fun event each Term. This Saturday, we have our Family Quiz Night in the School Gymnasium. 

How to Create an Account with myKindo

Please find below instructions on how to create an account with myKindo.

At the bottom of our newsletter you will find an Adobe version. Please open this document, where you will be able to click on the links.

Personalised Accounts on Kindo

We've now linked our Kindo school shop and school records, so life just got a whole lot easier for you and us!

You can now view your family account and see any outstanding payments, plus you have the option of making full or part payments for these items.

Already have an ezlunch or mykindo account?

Log in to our Kindo school shop.

Click on the 'Student Accounts' icon.

You may be asked to link the students from your account to the Schools records.

Click on the link and match your child to the student record held by the school and you're done.

Need to create an account?

New users can click here to create your myKindo account.



Enter in the email address the school has on file for you and click the 'next' arrow.

Student Accounts

You'll then receive an email with a link. Click on the link and enter in a password.

"Tick" to agree to the Terms and Conditions and click 'Continue'.

You can now use your email and password to login to the school shop and view you family account.

Viewing your personalised account.

When you click on the 'Student Accounts' service, you will see what is currently owing on your family account, for each of your students.



You can then choose to pay the full amount owing for each item by clicking on the +,

change the amount to make a part payment, before clicking on the +.

The item and payment will be added to your shopping cart.

For optional items, you can still click on your student's initial icon to add to your cart.



Using the calendar icon, you can order the same item for a number of different lunch days.

Once you have finished adding items to your cart, you can select Checkout.

Then simply click Place order at the checkout and you're done!
