CCET Update - The Next Project

Firstly, thank you! For choosing Cornerstone Christian School to invest into for your child's education is a commitment for their future and an endorsement of our shared vision to help them reach their full potential in God. Thank you.

The Cornerstone Christian Education Trust (CCET), the school Proprietors, hold an agreement with the Ministry of Education to operate Cornerstone Christian School with its own special character. It is a privileged position to partner with the Ministry and to be able to contribute to the education network here in the Manawatu.

It amazes me to think back to the property on Featherstone Street Palmerston North where we had just 3 classrooms, to the bold transition to our new site here at Mihaere Drive in 1998, and now to see the incredible campus that we have to enjoy here today. Kelvin Grove has grown and developed, as has our Cornerstone community and its footprint and we now have past students as teachers and students' children attending school. Wow!

On any journey, it is good to remind ourselves where we have come from, where we started, and it is also good to stop, to see the moments we are in right now in that journey, today. We also need to lift our eyes to the horizons to set the destination ahead. I am thankful to God for the vision that he set in the hearts of a group of families in 1986 to establish this school; I am thankful to God for the many who serve here today outworking that vision; I am thankful to God for the provision of today that will see the next generation carry it on.

CCET have committed to the construction of the next school project, Block I. Amidst the challenges of commencing an enrolment scheme

block, to see we are well placed for the years ahead. Next month, the earthworks will commence and we should see completion of Block I for the second term of 2022.

Please note - the all-weather turf is very much in our schedule of developments and we thank the community for the funds that are set aside for its construction in the next few years.

Provisioning growth of any organisation is always a challenge. I am very thankful for the common vision and spirit that is shared by our stakeholders, the CCET, BOT, Staff, students and parents of Cornerstone, as this enables wise planning by all in meeting the demands of developments ahead.

Thank you, Mr Mitchell and the staff, for your dedication to your passion as teachers and support staff here at Cornerstone. The influence you bring into our children's lives (and our own) is much appreciated and will echo in years to come.



We have our very own onsite after school care program here at Cornerstone from Monday to Friday 3pm-6pm.


We have been operating for 4 years and love serving our Community. Our staff have a heart for working with children, whilst honoring God. We love what we do, and would love to meet with you.


