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### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents/Kia ora te whanau/Malo e lelei/Talofa lava/Bula Vinaka/Konnichi wa/Kia orana/ Namaste/Welkom/Ni hao.

This morning I read a scripture verse that really jumped out at me. I have recently discovered the Passion Translation and have been re-reading the New Testament in this translation. I am up to Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians where chapter 5 and verse 16-18 reads:

"Let joy be your continual feast. Make your life a prayer. And in the midst of everything be always giving thanks, for this is God's perfect plan for you in Christ Jesus.."



I don't know about you, but at times it is easy for me to be overwhelmed by the challenges in front of me. I am learning slowly that being thankful is the key to 'letting joy be your continual feast' because if we are not thankful, then no matter how much we have, we will not be happy. There is something in human condition that will always want to have something bigger, something better or something more than what we have in our hands. Being thankful, is a way of life which asks us to notice all that is already present and abundant – from the tiniest things of beauty, to the grandest of our blessings – and in so doing, to take nothing for granted. We can learn to acknowledge that life is a gift. Even in the most challenging times, living thankfully, makes us aware of the opportunities that are always available; opportunities to learn and grow, and to extend ourselves with care and compassion to others.

For many of our staff here at Cornerstone, the start to the Term has been full of these challenges, with several of our staff struggling with grief over the recent loss of a family member. Others have had struggles with lingering sickness or family members who are sick. Yet in the midst of all of this, we have so much to be thankful for, both in our own lives and here at our awesome school: fantastic children, beautiful buildings, a great staff team, and a place where we can live out our faith in our workplace/place of study.

I want to take a moment to welcome all of our new new-entrant children who started this Term in Room A. What a fantastic bunch of students: Judah, Rameka, Micah, Jonathan, Olive, Janice and Sarah. Welcome all of you to Cornerstone Christian School. We pray that you all have a fantastic start to your schooling years and that you are able to learn, serve and grow in God!

### Tip # 1 Viewing your myKindo orders



### Tip #2 Changing schools & adding students using 'my details'

We have our very own onsite after school care program here at Cornerstone from Monday to Friday 3pm-6pm.


We have been operating for 4 years and love serving our Community. Our staff have a heart for working with children, whilst honoring God. We love what we do, and would love to meet with you.


