PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

Thank you everyone for bearing with us as we figure out how to operate our school in this current COVID-19 environment. As you may have seen in my email home last night, we are hoping that we have turned the corner with increasing numbers of students now recovering from COVID and returning back to school. We have also seen a tapering off in the reported number of student cases per day. Our key area of difficultly at present is staffing our school. This challenge has meant that we have had to ask the year 7 to 10 students to remain home this week. We will revise this decision on Sunday afternoon and will inform parents via the normal email channels. The irony is that our Teachers have all worked so hard to keep students in their classes safe and free from COVID but this has prolonged the impact of this pandemic on them personally.

Can I please encourage students who are remaining home, but not 'in isolation', to begin returning to school. As all parents know, it's great for any child or young person's wellbeing and learning to be at school with their friends, teachers and other school staff. Please be assured that we have good systems in place to keep everyone as safe as possible.

On Monday next week (4/4/22) all requirements around vaccine passes will be removed from the COVID protection framework. Additionally, as from last Friday (25th March) outdoor capacity limits are now removed and indoor meeting capacity limits were increased from 100 to 200 while still allowing for one-metre spacing. There is now also no expectation to scan in using the QR code at the gate, however we will leave these up at present. There are no mask requirements when outdoors but masks still remain a requirement indoors (and on the school bus) for staff and children/students in Years 4-13 – at least under the current Red setting.

Teacher Only Day Reminder

Please remember that we have a Teacher Only day on Friday 1st April (tomorrow) and the school will be closed for instruction for all students provided on this day. This day is our annual meeting of our Lower North Island Christian Schools Community of Learning (Kahui Ako) and while this year we will all be meeting via zoom, it is still a valued professional learning day for our school.

Welcome

I would like to extend a warm welcome to our newest staff member, Mrs Rebecca Jorgensen. Rebecca, who used to work in our school as an ESOL instructor has re-joined our staff team as the Principal's PA – a difficult job to be sure!! Mrs Sarndra Rauzi is not leaving us but will be moving sideways into Brian Gray's role as Executive Officer of the Cornerstone Christian Education Trust (CCET). Rebecca is married to Paul Jorgensen, who does an amazing job, teaching Robotics and keeping our IT systems spick and span. It's great to have you back on staff Rebecca!

Finally a thought I would like to share in the lead up to Easter. Many churches encourage members to consider the journey of Lent and I have been reflecting a lot on this in my own Quiet Time in the morning. I recently came across a quote from Martin Luther stating "Christianity is not a theology of glory, but a theology of the cross". Personally this is a hard lesson to learn. Like Peter, we may be inclined to argue with Jesus when he calls us to choose the way of the cross. In my humanness I often think "Surely not, Jesus! I don't want to suffer and lose, I want to be great and win!" But Jesus calls that kind of thinking satanic! As the book of Proverbs says, "There is a way that seems right to a person, but its end is the way to death." Most of us are scripted to think that life is a game and the purpose of life is to win. This is the way that seems right. But the divine truth is that life is a gift and the purpose of life is to learn to love well. And so Jesus invites us to follow him, not in a march to greatness, but in the cross-carrying way of self-denial.


Secondary students waiting after school

Saturday 16 April 2022 10-12pm Mangaone Stream near landfill.


