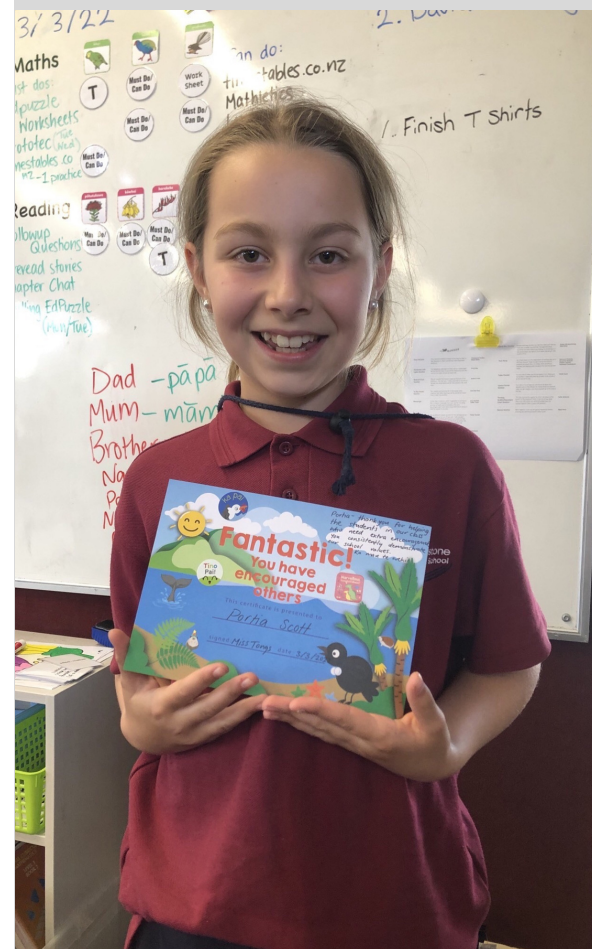
Optional - You may wish to consider providing a set of headphones/a mouse for your child. At this stage students are required to share the ones we have available.
