Kate Blincoe - Former Student



Kate Blincoe is a former student from Cornerstone Christian School. Kate's mum, Jannell Eade, is our Sports Co-Ordinator and a TA here at CCS.

Kate played all types of sports for Cornerstone while she was here, including hockey, touch rugby, Tee Ball, basketball and inter school rugby – ONCE. 😊 She participated in a variety of CCS inter school sports events, as well as doing Super Six competitions.

Kate was a competitive swimmer from age 7 through until her final national competition at age 14, including earning the 'top 10-year-old female swimmer in NZ' when she was a year 6 student at CCS. She played hockey, at school and representative level, including leading the Manawatu Under 18 Women's team to the national title in 2018. Kate also attended the NZ Junior Black Stick trials in 2021.

Kate earned a full academic and sporting scholarship to Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia, USA, starting in 2018. She studied Inter-disciplinary Health Services and played hockey for SJU, with her team winning the Atlantic 10 conference and progressing to the NCAA Championship. Sadly, due to COVID, Kate had to end her American adventure mid-way through her degree, so she returned to NZ and enrolled to study nursing at Massey University here in Palmerston North.

Since being back in New Zealand – Kate has played canoe polo for the Manawatu Women's A team AND the Manawatu Men's B team (in the A Grade). Kate captained the women's team to a national title this year and enjoys promoting the sport and encouraging new young players into the sport. (Amber and Kenzie Gray have started Canoe Polo so if any other CCS students want to give it a go, Kate is more than happy to give 1 on 1 tuition, just get in touch with Jannell).

Kate has recently been selected as the captain of the New Zealand Under 21 Women's Canoe Polo team to represent our country at the World Canoe Polo Championships in France in August. Canoe Polo is an intense sport, where core and upper body strength are crucial to being successful. Kate trains in the gym, does boat skills and water fitness, and plays in the local competitions. She does these activities for at least 7 sessions each week.

Kate looks back on her sporting journey at Cornerstone with great pride, acknowledging that Cornerstone always encouraged her to show outstanding sportsmanship, fair play, encouragement and acceptance of others, appreciation to coaches and managers, as well as working hard to achieve success in everything she did. Kate believes that her early Cornerstone sporting experiences instilled the excellent values that now come naturally to her – which have led to her being a confident, passionate, and very talented sportswoman. She feels that the way CCS always encourages students to 'give back' to their sport by way of coaching younger teams, as well as taking a genuine interest and care in supporting other players, have led to her earning leadership roles in many of her sports as she demonstrates outstanding values of inclusiveness and fairness.

Kate wishes to thank all the past and present Cornerstone staff, parents and students who have continued to follow and support her successful sporting career. "It takes a village to raise a child" is the mantra we feel applies to Kate – her Cornerstone 'Village' continues to have a huge impact on her life.

We have been operating for 4 years and love serving our community. Our staff have a heart for working with children, whilst honouring God. We love what we do, and would love to meet with you.

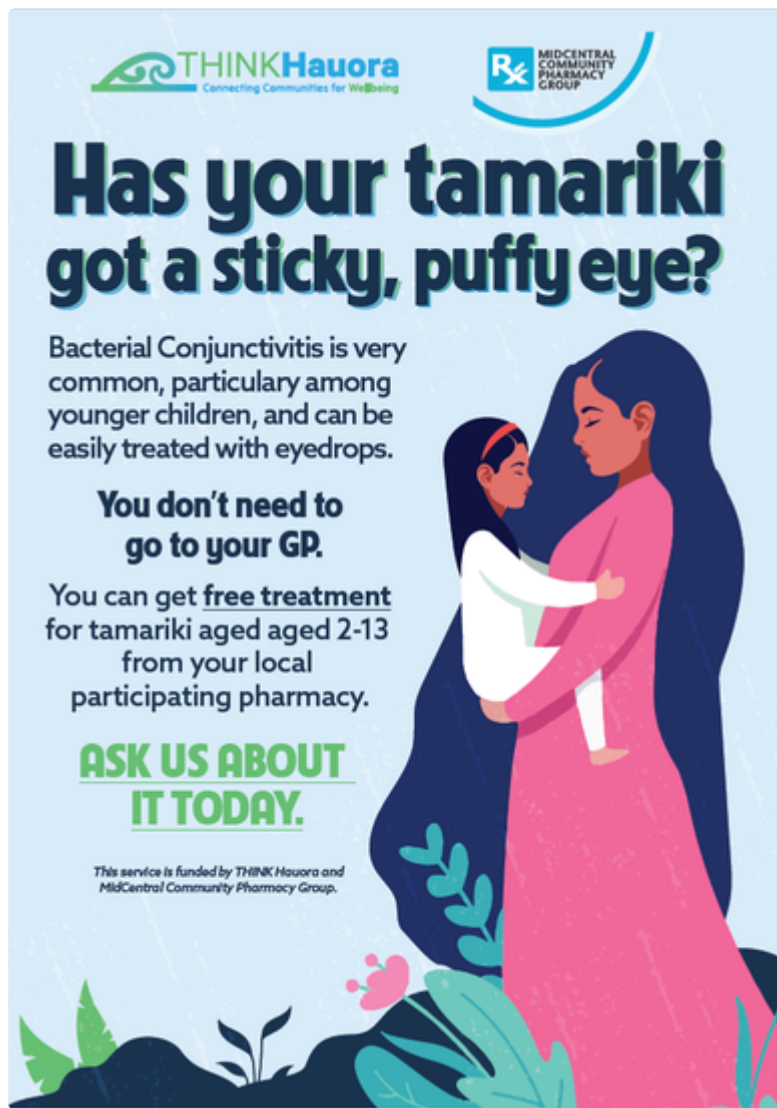
