Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.



## Lost Property

#### FAQ's about the Quiz night

#### Where is the School Gym?

Located at 119 Mihaere Drive, look for the big building on the town side of the school.

#### Will there be door sales?

As a non-gala year, we are looking at raising funds for the dance troupe, extra-curriculum activities and sports teams.




