#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

This week has been a good week at school despite personally struggling with one of the many winter bugs doing the rounds. Apologies if you have tried to contact me and I have not been available. While I was at home yesterday, I was reflecting on how a friend recently challenged me about the amount of time I spend on my phone; reading news, checking social media posts, following interesting (or totally useless) internet leads. I confess I spend way too much time looking at that little screen and I would hate to add up how much productive time I have frittered away since 'smartphones' became a thing! I've come to realise that the enemy of my Christian faith is not so much 'doubt', rather the enemy of my faith is more like 'certainty'. Often, gathering information is what gives us a sense of being certain about things. We worry what is going to happen tomorrow and so we search out information that helps to allay the fears that stalk us. We worry about illness and sickness and so we search out information that gives us a sense of being ok and in control. We worry about financial matters and so we search out information that gives us certainty that we have our dollar ducks in a row. All the time God says to us "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own." (Matthew 6:34). God, please help me to live in 'today' and not to spend my life future-tripping with concerns about tomorrow.

#### Teachers Only Day and the NCEA Change Programme

Thank you for keeping your children and young people home on Tuesday this week to allow Staff to engage in Professional time looking at the Aotearoa NZ Histories Curriculum which will become compulsory for all schools to teach in 2023. All of the secondary teachers who teach NCEA subjects spent time getting their heads around the new NCEA Change Programme that is being rolled out over the next four years. The aim of this Change Programme is to make NCEA more accessible to students with things like zero fees and fewer barriers for learners with disabilities and learning support needs. There will also be a strengthening of literacy and numeracy requirements and assessments to ensure all students with an NCEA qualification across NZ at least have functional literacy and numeracy skills going into tertiary education or the workplace. There will also be fewer, larger standards with new achievement standards and resources being developed to replace the existing.

#### Secondary Parent Information Evening

Next Thursday evening (1st September 2022) starting at 6.00pm in the Staffroom, we will be holding a Secondary Parent Information evening for all current and prospective year 6 parents (moving into year 7 in 2023) and year 8 parents (moving into year 9 in 2023). At this meeting we will outline our vision for secondary education at Cornerstone Christian School and what parents can expect for their young people. We have several proposed 'tweaks' in the pipeline that I am really excited about to ensure that our school remains a top achieving academic school with sound Christian discipleship.

Next week we have two secondary teams away travelling to regional competitions – the senior netball team and the senior basketball team. We pray for a safe, fun and competitive event for these students.

#### **Primary Production**




- · Harriet Haasbroek is our Afrikaans Learning Assistant


