Secondary Course Booklets out on Friday this week

Tomorrow the Secondary Course booklets for 2023 will be released. I would ask that Secondary students and parents read these booklets carefully and take time to consider what subjects they will opt into in 2023. Please remember that this booklet will look a little different to previous years as it now includes a 'senior subject matrix' where students make their 2023 subject choices from subject sets that the school can predictably offer in each timetable line. This is a revised method of course selection.

2023 Timetable Structure

I would like to signal to secondary parents now that we will be tweaking the timetable slightly in 2023. Next year we will operate a 10-day timetable made up of six subject lines. Year 7-13 students will start their day at 8:50am and finish at 3:00pm. Period lengths will be 60 minutes with the exception of three periods per week being split into a 30-minute subject class and a 30-minute Life Lab.

The Primary (year 1 to 6) timetable will remain the same starting at 9.00am and finishing at 3.00pm.

Have a fantastic term 3 break and we will see you all back bright and sparky for the new term.


