#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

Last night we held our final whole staff meeting for the year to ensure that we had all of our ducks in a row leading up to December 16th. It seems hard to believe that we have only twelve days of school left in 2022! I am really looking forward to our Primary and Secondary End of Year Celebrations and Prizegiving on Thursday 16th of December and also to the graduation celebration for our fifth ever graduating class on Saturday 10th December. In a media environment that is dominated daily by bad press around our nation's youth, I feel an overwhelming sense of hope when I look at our year 13 cohort that is graduating this year. In a couple of weeks' time, we will graduate 22 outstanding young men and women from Cornerstone Christian School who I know will make their mark on New Zealand (and the world), in a significant way. While that may sound a bit like a trite cliché, this truly is the reason why our school exists and why so many Palmerston North parents are beating down our doors to try and get their young people into Cornerstone Christian School. We definitely don't get it right all the time, but by and large we have a body of passionate staff who are helping shape the next generation for good. For this I am thankful that I daily get to come to work in a place that really matters!

This week on Monday our Cornerstone Choir Director, Mrs Vicki Campbell led our school in a fantastic and heartfelt end of year choir performance at Central Baptist Church. Well done students for your beautiful voices joined in harmony and praise to God. A special thank you to Mrs Campbell for her superb work guiding and coaching and directing our school choir this year!



Here are a few other key messages that we would like to communicate to parents:

#### 1. 2022 Student Reports and Class Lists for 2023

We will be sending out all final school reports for the year in the last week of term. In years 1 to 6 this will be a paper-based report in an envelope. In years 7 through 10 this will be an electronic report that is posted to the parent/student KAMAR portal. This year we have made the decision to post the 2023 class lists in with the final report (a paper copy in years 1-6 and on the KAMAR portal in years 7-10). In the past we have posted all class lists on our Cornerstone website however we have chosen to cease doing this due to the privacy issues this raises around release of private student information. #### 2. Manahau Team Leadership / Secondary Learning Support

Our year 3 and 4 Team / Syndicate here at Cornerstone Christian School is called the 'Manahau Team' and has been ably led by Mrs Jane Sutherland. Jane has decided to step down from this leadership role at the start of 2023 and has passed the baton to Mrs Vicki Campbell. Jane will be staying in her role as year 3 teacher in room D3. Thank you Jane for your incredible years of service and leadership!

Our SENCO (Special Education Needs Coordinator), Mrs Clare Long will be assisted in the secondary space in 2023 by Mrs Christina Havill whom we have appointed to the Learning Support Coordinator role (Secondary). This role fits well with the growing ESOL work that Christina carries out schoolwide. This year Mr Carl McIntyre has been assisting Clare with secondary learning support, however next year Carl has opted to focus more on his superb work around Careers and Tertiary (Gateway) placements and assisting Mr Craig McDonald with our tribes competition.




#### **Donation of Scrap Fabric**

#### **Arrival Time for All Students**


