PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

On Wednesday I felt like I watched a miracle take place here at Cornerstone Christian School. On Monday this week I followed one of those nudges you get from time to time and reached out to Gavin Clark, Principal of Hasting Christian School. As you know, much of the Hawkes Bay area was severely impacted as a result of an extreme flooding event on 14th February. Hastings Christian School was not physically affected by the cyclone however many of its staff and students were; some losing homes, businesses or even friends and associates as a result of what happened. Hastings Christian School resolved to do as much as they could to step in and serve those affected. Part of this was pulling together an army of volunteers to cater evening meals for all the Civil Defence workers coordinating relief efforts. Each night, through their food technology department Hastings Christian School have been feeding 120 workers at Riverbend Camp in Hastings. On Tuesday this week the head of foodtech, Renee, sent through a list of food supplies that were desperately needed due to supermarket shelves being cleaned out. I have to confess when I first saw the list of food needed, amounting to thousands and thousands of dollars worth of food I doubted that we would even get close. Well, come yesterday afternoon we did – thanks to all of you! We were able to pack the school minivan full of food and supplies and drive over to Riverbend Camp. I would like to especially thank our school exec officer Vicki Scoggins and her husband Gary for driving over Wednesday night. Thank you also to Rebecca Jorgensen who pulled the whole food order together. I would also like to acknowledge generous donations of food from Turners and Growers Ltd and Knead Bakery owned by school parents, Joel and Melinda Young. The good news is that we still have some money donated that will be used next week to assist with purchasing further food and supplies.

Thank you also to our School Community for taking time to meet with your child or young person's teacher(s) this past week. Great to see so many parents back in school. Apologies for a few lastminute cancellations – we do have reasonably high numbers of COVID cases at present amongst staff and students which messed up some of our teachers' plans this week.




Traffic Management Guidelines

We have some students who would love to be gifted a pair of preloved footwear for their chosen sport.




